



Top of Car Guardrails



Safety Commitment.

Top of Car Guardrails are required where a gap of 300mm or greater exists on the car rooftop. They are primarily used as a fall prevention safety feature to allow lift technicians to conduct rooftop maintenance and repair tasks safely.

Safety

To help ensure your lift complies with current legislative requirements, and to continually provide safe and efficient service to you, we highly promote the installation of guard rails to the top of the lift car to ensure conformance with state OHS regulations for building owners and the Australian Standard for Lift Installations.

Requirements

The Australian Standard AS1735 Part 2 Lift Code requires:

- Guardrails to be installed wherever there is a horizontal gap greater than 300mm.
- To be painted yellow.
- Have appropriate danger signage attached.
- Be of required height depending on the size of the gap.

Benefits

By fitting a top of car guardrail to your lifts:

- Be compliant with the current lift code.
- Improved safe working environment.
- Reduce the injury to lift technicians.
- Reduce risk associated with litigation.
- Possibly reduce Public Risk Insurance.
